

# GREYHOUNDS AS PETS COVID-19 VISITOR PROTOCOL

At Greyhounds as Pets, our number one priority is the safety of our visitors and staff alike. Due to the increasing number of COVID-19 cases in and throughout Sydney and surrounds, we have put in place a plan to ensure we can continue to provide adopters with the chance to meet their new greyhound, trainers the opportunity to continue to place their greyhounds in our care, and for our staff/volunteers to be able to keep enriching the lives of the greyhounds currently in care.

## FOR ADOPTERS

Greyhounds as Pets operates by appointment only for all adoption and foster meet and greets. Walk-ins will not be accepted and you will be turned away.

For those who book in an appointment, please see the below guidelines:

- Please arrive on time for your appointment, if you are running late, please call ahead to inform staff
- Call the appropriate number for the site you are visiting
  - Western Sydney: 0437 919 558
  - Wyee: 0447 651 128
- A staff member will come out to greet you and show you around to the backyard
- Please be aware that you will be asked to sign a visitor log on arrival to your appointment. This log will be located inside the office and we will ask that one member of your family fill the log in on behalf of all attendees, OR one person at a time will enter the office to fill in the log. There will be a pot of used pens and unused pens. Please take a clean pen, fill in the log and then place that pen in the 'used' pen pot. These will be disinfected at the end of every day.
- There is hand sanitizer available where your appointment will be held. Please use this upon first arriving, before and after signing paperwork and before you leave.
- There will be gloves and face masks available on request
- If you need to use the onsite facilities, please ask a staff member who will show you to the bathroom.

## FOR VOLUNTEERS/WORK PLACEMENT

If you are attending one of the adoption centres for the purpose of volunteering or conducting work placement, you are to sign in using the regular sign in sheet at the front door, and report directly to the volunteer coordinator/site manager of the facility.

You must abide by the following guidelines:

- Do not interact with owners/trainers or visitors to the centre. If someone has arrived, inform a staff member immediately
- Wash your hands regularly with soap and warm water. There are instructions on correct hand washing techniques above the sink in the bathroom
- Use hand sanitizer provided regularly

If you are feeling unwell, are showing symptoms, have been exposed to anyone who has returned a positive test OR you have visited an affected area, you are asked to please stay home and reschedule your appointment.
